My client Susan Smit	h disclosed to me o					
taken to the Teak hotel by a person named 'John' who she has just started a new relationship with. He was also with his friend 'Paul & Ben' who Susan had not met before. Susan would not tell me any of the male's surnames						
male's surnames. She stated she had originally agreed to carry out sex acts in exchange for £60 in total with the three males, however, once at the hotel lobby area she no longer felt comfortable with the arrangement but felt she 'could not leave'. Susan is a known sex worker in Middlesbrough and is a heavy crack cocaine user.						

Susan was visibly upset whilst explaining the incident, she went on to say that while she was waiting in the hotel lobby. She was hoping that hotel reception staff would question them whilst they were all checking in, as the hotel was only letting in limited guests due to Covid restrictions, but unfortunately they didn't ask them the nature of their stay. So she felt unable to raise the alarm/ask for help.

She stated that all three men remained in the room with her throughout the sexual acts and afterwards. She was given no money but she didn't argue with them as she 'just wanted to get out of there'. And felt if she did argue with them then they would have hurt her.

She was left feeling very low in mood as she thought that she was in a trusting relationship with John, once she got out of the hotel room she smoked a large amount of crack cocaine and needed support from the mental health crisis team and she was voicing to them she wanted to end her life.

I feel Susan has been sexually exploited as she was given no money for time she spent with the gentleman and was pressured into consenting to having sexual intercourse with all three men in a hotel room, which she was clearly scared to be in.

In addition I work with numerous ladies who sex work and I have come across the name John before, I believe his name is John Richardson, DOB: 23.04.1989 who has no fixed abode and has recently moved here from Manchester.

Making Safeguarding Personal (MSP) Please discuss with the Adult if safe and able to do so What are the views and wishes of the Adult?

I chatted with Susan at length about the role of safeguarding within Adult Social Care and what they could provide and I would support her throughout the process, Susan agreed for me to talk to Adult Social Care and also for a Claire's Law disclosure.

What would the Adult like to happen as an outcome of the Concerns?

I asked her what she would like to happen and Susan voiced that she wanted to end her 'relationship' with John. But is worried as he knows where she lives and he also supplies her with substances, so she may have to return to him so she doesn't go into withdrawal.

SECTION 2 DETAILS OF CONCERN BEING RAISED

TYPE OF ABUSE

Discriminatory

Includes abuse based on a person's race, sex, disability, faith, sexual orientation, or age; other forms of harassment, slurs or similar treatment or hate crime/hate incident.

Domestic

An incident or pattern of incidents of controlling, coercive or threatening behaviour, violence or abuse by someone who is or has been an intimate partner or family member regardless of gender or sexuality. It can include: psychological, physical, sexual, financial, emotional abuse; 'honour' based violence; Female Genital Mutilation; forced marriage.

Financial and Material

Includes theft, fraud, exploitation, pressure in connection with wills, property or inheritance or financial transactions, or the misuse or misappropriation of property, possessions or benefits.

Modern Slavery

Encompasses slavery, human trafficking, forced labour and domestic servitude. Traffickers and slave masters use whatever means they have at their disposal to coerce, deceive and force individuals into a life of abuse, servitude and inhumane treatment.

Neglect and Acts of Omission

Includes ignoring medical or physical care needs, failure to provide access to appropriate health, social care or educational services, the withholding of the necessities of life, such as medication, adequate nutrition and heating.

Organisational

Includes poor care practice within an institution or specific care setting like a hospital or care home. This may range from isolated incidents to continuing ill-treatment.

Psychological

Includes emotional abuse, threats of harm or abandonment, deprivation of contact, humiliation, blaming, controlling, intimidation, coercion, harassment, verbal abuse, isolation or withdrawal from services or supportive networks.

Physical

Includes hitting, slapping, pushing, kicking, misuse of medication, restraint or inappropriate sanctions.

Sexual Abuse

Includes rape and sexual assault, sexual acts to which the adult has not consented, could not consent or was pressured into consenting.

Sexual Exploitation

Involves exploitative situations and relationships where people receive 'something' (e.g. accommodation, alcohol, affection, money) as a result of them performing, or others performing on them, sexual activities.

Self-Neglect

Covers a wide range of behaviour; neglecting to care for one's personal hygiene, health.

SECTION 5

LOCATION OF ALLEGED INCIDENT/CONCERN

Own Home

The residence where the adult at risk usually lives. Includes property owned/rented by the individual, family or friends.

Care Home – Nursing

Can be used whether the person is at the care home on a permanent or temporary basis.

Care Home – Residential

Can be used whether the person is at the care home on a permanent or temporary basis.

Supported Living

Can include any type of supported accommodation, such as independent living.

Day Centre/Community Service

Can include things like community centres, day care centres, leisure centres, libraries, schools, GP surgeries and dental surgeries.

Alleged Perpetrator's Home

Can include any incident that occurs in the home of the abuser.

Hospital / Health Setting

Can include any type of hospital premises. The individual at risk could be a patient or a visitor.

Other

Includes any other setting that does not fit into one of the above categories. This could include businesses, offices, pubs and other people's homes.
