What are Safe Places?

These are places in the community where you can go if you don't feel safe or need some help.

How can a Safe Place help you?

- A safe and friendly place
- A place to sit and have a rest if you are lost or unwell
- People to understand and listen
- Staff that can provide help and advice
- Staff who can call someone you know

Why would you use a Safe Place?

You can go to a Safe Place if you:

- Need some help and advice
- Feel lost, upset or afraid
- Feel bullied or scared
- Have lost your belongings
- Have lost your friends, family or the person who cares for you

These places can help anyone if they don't feel safe.

Just knowing about Safe Places can help you feel safer to go out on your own or with your friends.
